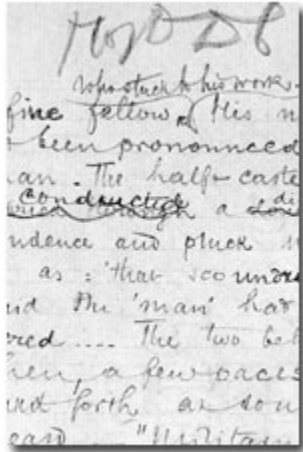


ST MARY'S CONRAD COLLOQUIA ON TEXTUAL STUDIES: COLLOQUIUM 2
